Shaping Future Managers for the Further Development of Armenia and French-Armenian Relations

"French University in Armenia" Foundation is an institution of higher education established in 2000 by the Governments of France and Armenia. The founders of the FUA; the Ministry of Education and Science and that of External Affairs of the Republic of Armenia, the Ministry of Foreign and International Development of France and the Embassy of France in Armenia, have repeatedly highlighted the importance that they attach to education and formation of Armenian youth for the wellbeing of Armenia and French-Armenian relations.

The representatives of the Embassy of France, French and Armenian Ministries of Foreign Affairs, the Ministry of Education and Science of the RA are members of the Board of Trustees of the FUA.

In line with its mission statement, the FUA awards double state diplomas (those of Republics of Armenia and France), due to its partnership with the University Jean Moulin Lyon 3:

Double State Diplomas

- Armenian "Bakalavr" and French "Licence",
- Armenian "Magistros" and French "Master".

French-Armenian Faculty and Administrative Staff

The mission of the university is ensured by a French-Armenian team, under the governance of a French rector.

French Accreditation

French diplomas, that are being awarded by the FUA due to the partnership with the University Jean Moulin Lyon 3 are accredited by the High Council for Evaluation of Research and Higher Education (HCERES) and are evaluated by the decree of French Republic. This French accreditation, which is recognized in Armenia, endows the FUA with the opportunity to award its alumni two state diplomas: Armenian and French: "Bakalavr" /"Licence" and "Magistros"/"Master".

Academic programmes accredited by France

In conformity with Bologna principles, the academic process is organized per semesters and allows for credit attainment in line with European Credit Transfer System (ECTS). In its turn, this endows our students with the opportunity to continue their education in all European universities and those worldwide.

The FUA carries out its academic operations in 4 faculties:


- Law Marketing

The key objective of Licence/Bakalavr is to prepare students who have acquired fundamental knowledge, competences and skills to ensure their successful professional insertion and/or provide sufficient grounds for their further education. Moreover, the knowledge harvested allows our alumnito occupy junior posts.

Preparatory courses for admission to undergraduate studies

Preparatory courses train the student for the entry exams to the first cycle of education and hence the programmes incorporate the topics to be covered throughout entry exams (mathematics, social sciences, Armenian and foreign languages: French, English or German).

Graduate Studies

The FUA offers graduate programmes which are adapted to the needs of the country. The objective of said programmes is to form high-level specialists in line with Armenian labour-market demands and to create favourable conditions with the aim of implementing the knowledge, competences and skills acquired by our students for the development of Armenia. Not only theoretical knowledge but also practical skills are developed with the aim of offering our students a thorough toolkit necessary for becoming managers: the ability to take up leadership and delegate responsibilities.


Graduate studies are conducted by an array of specialists from different pedagogical domains: French experts who are often renowned researchers and also experts from social-economic field which is the token of an indispensable professional dimension opening doors to employability. From 2016 some portion of studies will be carried out in English.

Graduate academic programmes are carried out in three faculties: Marketing and Trade, Finance and Control and International Business Law.

- MA in Marketing and Trade aims at preparing specialists in the domains of trade, marketing and communication.
- MA in Finance and Control aims at preparing specialists in the domains of banks, financial institutions, assurance companies, audit organizations and etc.
- MA in International Business Law aims at preparing lawyers for the Chambers of Commerce and Industry, financial and international institutions. The alumni can work as legal advisors, consultants or lawyers.




